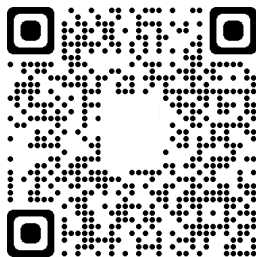
Prayer Meeting— Wednesdays at 6:30pm in the parlour. You can also join through Zoom.
